The New England Society for Abandoned Animals, a charitable 501 (c) (3) organization, registered with the Massachusetts Attorney General's Office, has the following mission: To advocate, protect and rescue, abandoned and abused animals using a proactive, humane approach. It is committed to its "no kill" programs, increasing community awareness and creating progressive changes in animal welfare.

NESAA is always looking for adoption parents, foster parents and for volunteers to support its activities as well as for its no-kill Shelter and Education Center in Centerville. The shelter typically has about 50-100 cats and kittens in its care but at the moment, is caring for almost 200 cats and kittens.

The shelter is always looking for cat food, litter, bleach, Windex, Clorox clean-up, paper towels, beach size towels and trash bags.
